Winter Xtreme

2012

What? Winter Xtreme is an incredible weekend retreat for high school students. We will join several other high school students at Camp Timber Lee in East Troy, WI. We will stay in their heated cabins, hang out with and meet new friends, have a lot of fun, and experience an incredible time with God! This trip is a great way to meet God (perhaps for the first time) and begin lifelong friendships with other students. Here's what to expect at Winter Xtreme:

- An atmosphere that is welcoming, friendly, and fun for high school students.
- Truth. Fresh, engaging, and energizing biblical messages.
- Time to encounter God in His creation.
- New and deeper friendships.
- Hours of free time and activities including snow tubing, tobogganing, karaoke, a broomball tournament, time in the game room, an espresso bar, and many more activities! (Note: Some extra activities such as horseback riding and cross country skiing will cost a little extra).

Winter Xtreme will be the highlight of your winter and possibly your life.

Who? Any high school student can attend Winter Xtreme.

Where? Camp Timber-Lee in East Troy, Wisconsin. You can be dropped off and picked up at Whitnall High School (5000 S 116th St. Greenfield, WI).

When? Leave on Friday, February 3 at 6:00 PM (Eat dinner before hand) and return around 1:00 PM on Sunday, February 5. (We will have students call parents when we're an hour away).

How much? Total trip cost is \$175. A deposit of **\$50 IS DUE ON DECEMBER 18**. The remaining \$125 and permission forms are due on January 22, 2012. The \$175 covers transportation to and from Timber-Lee, lodging, food, and several activities. Students may want to bring extra money to purchase t-shirts, snacks, and extra activities. This could be as little or as much as you would like.

First come first serve– Winter Xtreme sells out quickly, and we only have a limited number of spots. Get your deposit in early to guarantee your spot!

A note about money– DON'T LET MONEY BE THE REASON YOU DO NOT GO TO THIS EVENT. If you do not have the financial resources to cover your cost, please talk to Tyler. We can discuss some possible fund raisers, payment plans, or scholarship opportunities.

How to sign up– Turn in your DEPOSIT on or before December 18. The remaining balance and permission forms are due on or before January 22, 2012. These deadlines allow us to turn in our registrations and determine the number of team members and drivers we will need.

Travel and Accommodations– Your safety is very important to us. We are planning this trip to reduce the risk of injury for each person on the trip. We will have a good adult-to-student ratio. We will take every precaution to ensure that the vehicles used on the trip are safe. Our drivers will have the proper licenses and proper training to travel with you in the vehicles we use.

What to Bring

- Bible and pen
- Sleeping bag or linens
- Toiletries
- Flashlight
- Pillow
- Snow Clothes (snow pants, boots, scarves, gloves, etc.)
- Towel and washcloth
- Shoes and socks
- Clothes for two nights and two days– dress warm!
- Spending money for the store, snacks, and other activities.
- Good attitude and desire to learn.

What to Leave at Home

- Cell phone
- iPod/mp3 player
- Video games
- Valuable jewelry or anything expensive.
- Silly string, fireworks, or other prank items.
- Cigarettes, alcohol, or any illegal drugs.

As much as you want to bring your cell phone, iPod, or other electronics, it is a good challenge to leave that stuff behind and be open to God to speak to you for a weekend!

Student Expectations

Camp Timber-lee and The Ridge Community Church expect a certain code of conduct of all students and leaders who attend Winter Xtreme. Failure to meet these expectations may result in disciplinary actions that could include being sent home at the expense of the student. We do not anticipate any problems, but we want to make these expectations clear. By signing up for Winter Xtreme, the student and parent agrees to these expectations and any necessary disciplinary actions.

- Students and leaders are NOT to enter the opposite gender's restroom, showering facility, or sleeping quarters.
- Students and leaders are NOT to be alone one on one with anyone of the opposite gender.
- Students and leaders are NOT to bring any cigarettes, alcohol, or any form of illegal drugs. (Please contact Tyler about any prescribed medications when signing up for Winter Xtreme).
- Students and leaders will keep all PDA to just hand holding or hugs. Don't gross anyone out!
- Physical violence, gossiping, or verbal threats will not be tolerated.
- Students will listen to all adult leaders from The Ridge and Camp Timber-Lee.
- Students and leaders will attend all large group and small group worship gatherings.
- Students and leaders will all have good attitudes, fun energy, and be ready to laugh, connect to others, and connect to God!
